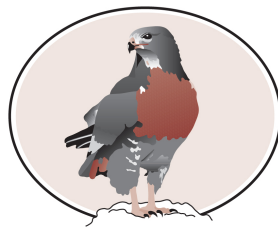

Mount Anderson Reserve is a unique and exclusive mountain retreat set on 7 300ha (20 000 acres) of dramatic landscape in the Mpumalanga escarpment, west of the Kruger National Park. It is an idyllic getaway for those seeking refuge from the rigors of everyday city life and offers the perfect opportunity to relax and unwind in one of South Africa's most exquisite and private nature reserves. The property is blessed with spectacular scenery and mesmerizing views while still offering access to rare and endangered wildlife and some of the most unique vegetation in the country. Mount Anderson is steeped in history and is the site of the largest gold nugget ever found in South Africa. Golden Cottage, the reserve's luxury lodge, was painstakingly crafted from hand-hewn rose shale and features graceful rooms with tall ceilings and airy windows. Situated in a secluded valley, it overlooks crystalline trout ponds and while you might occasionally hear the bark of baboons from the cliff tops, the only disturbance to one's solitude is the sound of Africa's game approaching the streams to drink.

Activities

- **All activities are planned together with and conducted by an experienced guide.**
- **Trout fishing** in 24 weirs and two large lakes. Fly-fishing rods and reels are available.
- **Wildlife safaris** on foot or in a 4-wheel drive vehicle.
- **Horse riding** - on mountain ponies for intermediate and experienced riders.
- **Mountain bike riding** - exhilarating and some courses technically challenging.
- **Hiking trails** - range from gentle riverside ambles to a challenging hike and climb. Includes beautiful waterfalls, San rock art painting, ancient Pedi tribe ruins and relics of the gold mining era from 1880-1900.
- **Camera traps, orienteering, zip lines, rowing boats, swimming and picnics.**
